- **Tournament Sanction USJA sanction: USJA 11-041**
- **Eligibility:** A valid card from USJF, USJI or USJA must be presented at registration by all competitors. Competitors who are citizens of other countries may show a valid card from their country's national judo organization. There will be no exceptions. Membership forms will be available during registration.
- **No Spectator Fee** – Concessions will be available all day. Please, no outside coolers.

Chokes allowed for contestants age 13 or older

Arm locks allowed for Senior and Master contestants age 17 and older.

Golden Score will apply. True Double Elimination for all pools except 3 and 4 player pools which will fight Round Robin. Best 2 out of 3 matches for 2 competitors. Competitors are responsible for providing their own BLUE and WHITE BELTS for this competition.

All Juniors, Masters, Newaza, Grappling, Women and Novice divisions - 3 minute matches

All Men Brown and Black Belt divisions - 4 minute matches

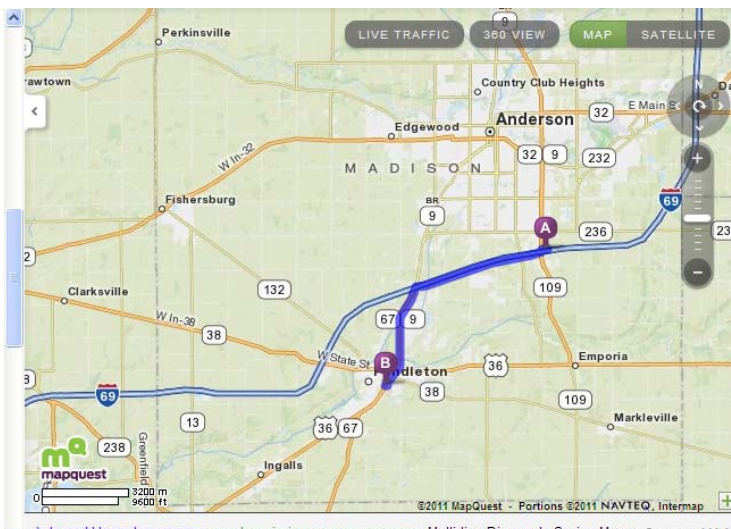

Major restaurants located within walking distance of hotel – Directions from host hotel to venue:

1. Start out going WEST on E 59TH ST toward S SCATTERFIELD RD/IN-9 N. 0.2 mi
2. Take the 1st LEFT onto S SCATTERFIELD RD/IN-9 S. 0.08 mi
 If you reach APPLEWOOD CENTER DR you've gone a little too far
3. Merge onto I-69 S/IN-67 S/IN-9 S toward INDIANAPOLIS. 3.5 mi
 If you are on S SCATTERFIELD RD and reach E 64TH ST you've gone about 0.2 miles too far
